

# WHAT IS AN MAJOR RISK ? WHAT TO DO ?

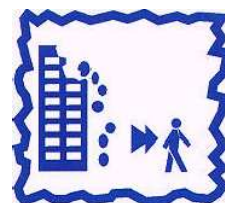
The city of SAINT-LOUIS is concerned by 3 major risks :  
**Earthquakes, industrial risks and transport of dangerous goods.**

## EARTHQUAKE

### DURING THE SHOCK



① If you are inside a building, **shelter under a solid pièce of furniture** (table, bed...). Do not run away during the shock.



② If you are on the street, **get away from buildings and cables**. Shelter under a porch

If you are in a car, **stop far from buildings and cables. Stay inside your car.**

### AFTER THE FIRST SHOCK : beware of the aftershocks



① **Listen to the radio**  
 Radio France Bleu Alsace (FM 102.6)  
 Radio Dreyeckland (FM 104.6)



② Turn off electricity and gas  
 Do not smoke. Avoid to switch on or off the light or any electrical device / apparel. Any flame or sparkle could provoke an explosion. In case of lack, open doors and windows and call authorities.



③ **Evacuate the building**, taking with you identity card, radio with batteries, flashlight and spare batteries, warm clothing, your medicine.  
**Do not use the elevator.**  
**Do not use the phone.**



④ **Do not pick up your children at school**

The teachers know the instructions. The look after your children, get them in a safe place, and reassure them. Moreover, when moving you could put yourself unnecessarily in danger and disturb the rescue squads.

# INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT AND TRANSPORT OF DANGEROUS GOODS

## ① GED INSIDE



**If you are at home**, at your work or in a public building : Stay where you are and lock **yourself in**. Do not drive away, you could be in danger on the street and disturb the circulation of the rescue vehicles.

**If you are outside. Enter the nearest building.** Do not stay outside, you will be more exposed to possible dangers.

**If you are in your car : Park your car, turn off the engine and enter the nearest building.** You are not safe in your car.

## ② CLOSE EVERYTHING



An enclosed room slows down the penetration of possible gases or radioactive goods.

**Shut doors and windows. Switch off or block up ventilation.** In case some of your windowpanes have been broken during the accident, shelter in a room with intact windows (or no windows at all).

## ③ LISTEN TO THE RADIO

## ④ DOT NOT PICK UP YOUR CHILDREN AT SCHOOL



**your children are safer at school than on the street.** The teachers know the instructions. They look after your children, get them in a safe place and reassure them. Moreover, when moving you could put yourself unnecessarily in danger and disturb the rescue squads.

## ⑤ NO FLAME, NO SPARKLE



**Do not smoke.** Avoid to switch on or off the light or any electrical device/apparel. Any flame or sparkle could provoke an explosion.

## ⑥ DO NOT USE THE TELEPHONE



**The telephone lines** have to be kept free/clear for emergencies and rescue. Informations will be given to you on the radio.
